The Drug Take-Back Day provides an opportunity for the public to surrender expired, unwanted, or unused pharmaceutical controlled substances and other medications for destruction. These drugs are a potential source of supply for illegal use and an unacceptable risk to public health and safety. Acceptable items to bring to the Drug Take Back event are; Prescription and over the counter solid dosage medications to include tablets and capsules
