Entry to Graduation Ceremony

• Graduates and their family need to arrive during the scheduled arrival time (by alpha) and park in the junior lot, senior lot, library lot, or along the bus lane.

Graduate Last Names G - M arrive 4:00 - 4:30 p.m.

Graduate Last Names A – F arrive 4:30 – 4:50 p.m.

• Graduates and their family need to proceed to the soccer field and get into line at one of the eight health screening stations (**designated by Alpha**) available for check-in.

Please stay on markers to socially distance from other families while waiting and wear masks during the entire process and ceremony.

- After completing the health screening process, please follow signs and proceed to your designated seats on the football field. Graduates and families will sit together (see map below).
- Gathering among different families will NOT be allowed. Please remain in your seats.
- Restrooms are available to the south of the football field. Please socially distance while waiting for the restroom.

During the Ceremony

- Graduates will remain seated until their row is directed to move to the waiting area.
- Graduates will wait at the end of the ramp to the stage until their name is called. Please be aware that we will be calling names of those graduates that are not attending too.
- When the graduate's name is called, they will proceed to the stage and take a photo with Principal Paxton by standing on the 'X'. The graduate may remove their mask for the photo. Graduates may bring their diploma covers to the ceremony for the photo.
- Please proceed down the opposite ramp and back to your seat.

After the Ceremony

- Please remain in your seat until each row is released for dismissal. Faculty and staff will be released first then graduates and families.
- Congregating after the ceremony will not be allowed, please proceed to your vehicle.

Fall Semester Instructional Schedule

In preparation for the restart of school at Conifer High School, I am excited to share our hybrid schedule with our parents and students. Hopefully the following information will answer many of your questions and help with our students' transition back to school.

Unlike the spring semester, student and teacher engagement will follow a synchronous learning model where students and teachers will interact either online or in-person at the same time (i.e. Biology class at 9:00 a.m.). Students will be required to use their Chromebook or personal device to complete assigned tasks and assessments provided by the teacher.

Virtual and In-Person Seminar

Students arriving on a Conifer area school bus will be provided in-person seminar starting at 7:45 a.m. in conjunction with the Bus Buffer time starting when the student's bus arrives.

Students not riding a Conifer area school bus will be provided an option of inperson seminar or virtual seminar starting at 7:45 a.m.

All students will need to log into their virtual Seminar class for attendance taking and grade calculation (see Student Handbook for Seminar grade calculation requirements).

In-Person Lunch and School Dismissal

All students will be provided time for in-person lunch starting at 1:40 p.m. Students riding a Conifer area school bus will have assigned seats in accordance with their bus grouping that follows social distancing. Buses will leave the Conifer campus at 2:00 p.m.

Student wishing to leave school (parent pick up and student drivers) are dismissed at 1:40 p.m.

The Conifer school building will be closed to students at 2:00 p.m. for cleaning and sanitization.

Virtual Learning Support

Friday's Virtual Learning Support days will serve our diverse learners with the opportunity to connect with their teachers when necessary. Conifer's intervention model will also utilize Fridays to support struggling students with individualized support. Teachers will post an asynchronous attendance task that all students must complete in order to be marked present for the day. From time to time, individual or student groups will be required to engage in synchronous learning to support the student(s) learning needs.
