New Graduation Requirements for Class of 2022 Attention Juniors, the State Board of Education has established new graduation requirements that students will need to complete in order to graduate from Conifer High School. The graduation requirements for the class of 2021 will be based solely on successful completion of the required 23 credits. The **demonstration of knowledge** for graduation readiness will still be required for the graduating classes of 2022 and beyond.

11th Grade students in Colorado can add the SAT® with Essay to their SAT School Day registration for free. The Colorado Department of Education will cover all fees so you can take the SAT with Essay during the school day on April 13th. The window to sign up is January 18 - February 16, 2021.
