Class activities—Announcements, assignments, and questions recently posted by teachers. Email summaries do not include grades. For grades, you will need to login to <u>Jeffco</u> Campus and check your student's grades there. We are asking that you please click accept once you receive the invite so that you can see the weekly progress of your student's activities. Thank you for your support! **Technology** Tip #1: Students, please make sure you charge your device for school every night so **Troubleshooting Tips** that you are prepared for school the next day. If Chromebooks drop below 5% battery life, the device will stop working and will require a full charge before working again. We recommend charging at night so that you have a full battery each day. Tip #2: Students, clear cache and cookies in Chrome once a week in order to help your Chromebook & device perform better. Sometimes Chrome saves data that conflicts with things you are trying to do. Cleaning it up often helps! Here is a

video showing you how to clear cache & cookies.
