In Remembrance of 9/11

Please take a moment to remember those lost on this date in 2001. The United States of America was attacked in an unprecedented fashion, leading to the deaths of over 3,000 men and women in New York City, Arlington, Virginia and Shanksville, Pennsylvania. Week One of Hybrid Learning

I want to thank our parents, students, and especially our teachers, for the successful launch of hybrid learning this week.

It would go a long way if I could have our parents and students share their positive experiences to **thank our teaching staff**. They are working exceptionally hard to ensure every student is provided with a quality education every day, whether remote or in-person. As the students can attest to, the teachers have done amazingly well at overcoming the daily technical obstacles and software issues.

In addition, I need for all students to **change their profile picture in Google Classroom and Zoom** to an appropriate current photo. This could include their senior picture, school photo, or recently taken photo. This will better assist teachers with identifying students online.

When students login into a class, it is important for the **student to remain in the class for the duration of instruction** (including personal practice, group activity, assessment, or teacher review). We understand that technical issues may disconnect students, so they should try to reconnect or call the number for the Google Meet or Zoom meeting.

I need parent and student assistance as we refine our practices, which will include some noticeable changes in the coming weeks:

Morning Drop-Off in the Bus Circle:

• Bus circle will open for student drop-off at 7:20 a.m. Use the Lobo circle for student drop-off before 7:20 a.m.

Breakfast and Lunches:

- All breakfast and lunches are free for all students through December.
- Student can access the food in the Conifer Commons.

Afternoon Pick-Ups:

• Due to the staging of buses, the <u>bus circle</u> is closed for afternoon <u>pick-ups</u>. Students can only be picked up from Lobo circle (front entrance).

Seasonal Allergies

In an attempt to limit the spread of COVID-19, it is important to promptly identify, separate, and ensure that symptomatic students are evaluated and treated as necessary. Many possible COVID-19 symptoms may be similar to common allergy symptoms and it is often difficult to tell the difference.

If your child experiences known seasonal allergies, please request a note from your child's medical provider stating what typical symptoms your child may exhibit when experiencing allergies. This will allow the district nurse to have a baseline of possible symptoms for your child and will be less likely to send your student home for suspected illness.

The medical provider must be licensed in the state of Colorado and have current prescriptive privileges.

The medical provider note should include the following:

- What the child is allergic to
- What symptoms are typical for the child
- What allergy medications the child takes to treat symptoms

Each symptomatic child will be evaluated on a case by case basis and the district RN may be contacting you for more information.

Food Service Update

Great News! The United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) granted significant waiver extensions that allow all students to receive breakfast and lunch meals at no cost through December 31, 2020, regardless of free and reduced-price meals eligibility.

In January meal charges will return, therefore, families should still proceed with completing a Free and Reduced-Price Meals application at the start of the year.

Starting September 14th, we will expand to provide meals for remote learners at all sites. And, hybrid learners will be able to pick up meals for their remote learning days at their home site at the end of the in-person learning school day, starting at 2:05 p.m.

Reminders for families:

- Create a SchoolCafé account if you don't already have one
 - Add money to student accounts on SchoolCafe
 - View school menus on SchoolCafe
 - Meals through December 31, 2020 are available at no cost to all students
 - Students who wish to purchase a la carte items will need their student ID number,
 whether using funds from their SchoolCafé account or cash/check
- Complete a Free and Reduced-Price Meals application, if applicable

Drive-In Access to WiFi Hotspots

Based on popular request for additional internet options, we're providing WiFi hotspot access for students on the west end of the bus lane. The parking spots are available from 7:45 in the morning until 1:35 in the afternoon. There is a time limit of two-hours if other students need access too, and there is no access to the building.
