Current COVID Guidelines – July 2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • State Public Health Order (PHO) 20-38 was amended July 1st and school districts are no longer required to follow the CDPHE Guidance - Cases and Outbreaks in Schools. A new version of this guidance is estimated to be published late July/beginning of August. • CDC School Guidance updated and released July 9th recommends all unvaccinated individuals in the school setting wear masks, including ages 2-11. • Families should continue to follow the home screening tool and students are NOT PERMITTED to come to school if they feel ill with COVID-like symptoms. • Social distance is still recommended as much as possible for unvaccinated individuals, but no requirements of 3 or 6 feet at this time. • Positive cases are still required to isolate for 10 days. • School visitors and volunteers should wear a mask if not fully vaccinated.

<p>Bleacher Progress “Providing Conifer with Exceptional Facilities”</p>	<p>The Conifer Lobos Unified Boosters (CLUB) is excited to announce that they are finally able to move forward with the construction of the highly anticipated bleachers (1,500+ seats) at Conifer High School!</p> <p>With the dedicated help of Conifer families and community member volunteers, they have been building two (2) 180’ long block retaining walls out of landscape blocks which weigh about 60 lbs./block. Once these two retaining walls are built, they will begin the process of assembling the bleachers.</p> <p>If you can help, please visit their Sign-Up Genius to volunteer: https://www.signupgenius.com/go/10C084AABAE23A20-volunteers. <u>They will need 8-10 volunteer workers each day.</u> This is the critical stage of their bleacher building process and They greatly appreciate your commitment to helping our Conifer community. Student volunteers will be rewarded with Conifer Lobo Service Hours that will count towards your “200 Club” service hour goals! They will have a sign-in sheet each day and all workers will need to sign a waiver prior to working.
